### Jelly Roll Sawtooth Star with Carolyn Forster

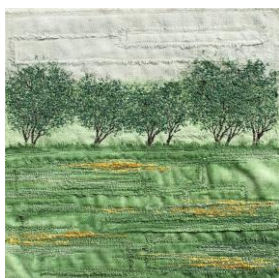

### Latticework and fussy cutting with Sylvie Plested,

who is an accredited teacher of Eleanor Burns' patterns  
You will work on your lattice first before fussy cutting your feature fabric to highlight the design.

For example if you were fussy cutting elephants it could look like the elephants were passing from one square to the next.

**Interchange appliqué with Gillian Travis**

A new and very effective way of making bonded appliqué quilted items based on taking a simple shape. The design work is simple; the placing of the colours and patterns can be the key to making a successful piece of textile art that can be a cushion, wall hanging or set of table mats.

It works best with batiks but other fabrics can be used.
