Lotus leaf covering cloth

Used to cover tea sets and food this covering cloth is made from Korean silk organza. This is made using a technique known as Kojipji (Pinching technique). You will learn how to design and make your own unique lotus leaf on paper before transferring this to the fabric. You will learn how to create organza flowers to decorate the handle as well as the folding technique used to complete the hem.

Requirement list:

Sara will bring kits with all the fabrics needed for the workshop project (cost £8.00). Sara will also provide the thread.

To bring:

- A pair small of sharp scissors
- A fine hand sewing needle e.g. Clover No. 9
- Applique needle,
- Thimble
- A Hera marker (creaser)
- 12” rotary cutting type ruler
- A2 cutting mat
- A pencil
