Workshop: Recycled/Vintage Cottage Garden

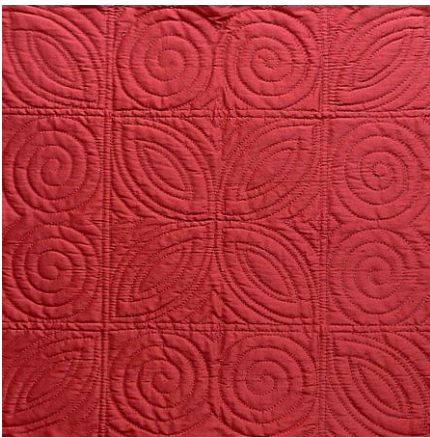
Search through your fabrics for florals to appliqué and collage. Couch, embellish and hand embroider to complete. The piece can be made into a cushion, tote bag or framed picture.
