

Modern Quilting: Log Cabin Variations

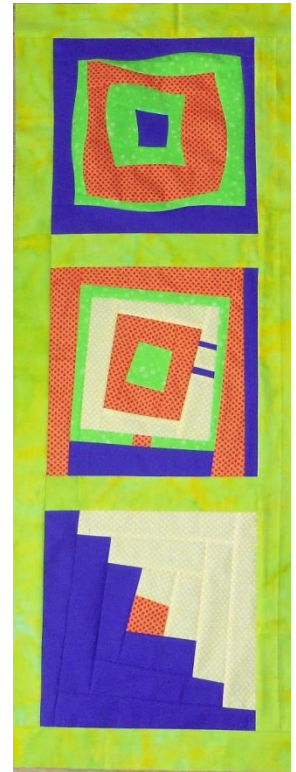
Approx size: 44" x 16"

Materials (100% cotton):

- Four fat quarters for the blocks
 - *modern quilters often use a combination of bright and/or neutral fabrics in their work, frequently in solid, or nearly solid colours. You can, of course, use whatever fabric you wish but fabrics with directional prints (eg stripes) or large prints can be difficult to use in this project.*
- Half yard of complementary fabric to make your blocks up into a hanging
- Wadding and backing fabrics slightly larger than finished size

General requirements:

- Basic sewing kit including small scissors and pins
- Machine thread for piecing and quilting
- Cutting board and ruler. Large square if you have one (12½" or larger)
- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- Sewing machine including general purpose foot and quilting foot
- Pins / glue for basting quilt layers
- Glasses if you wear them!
